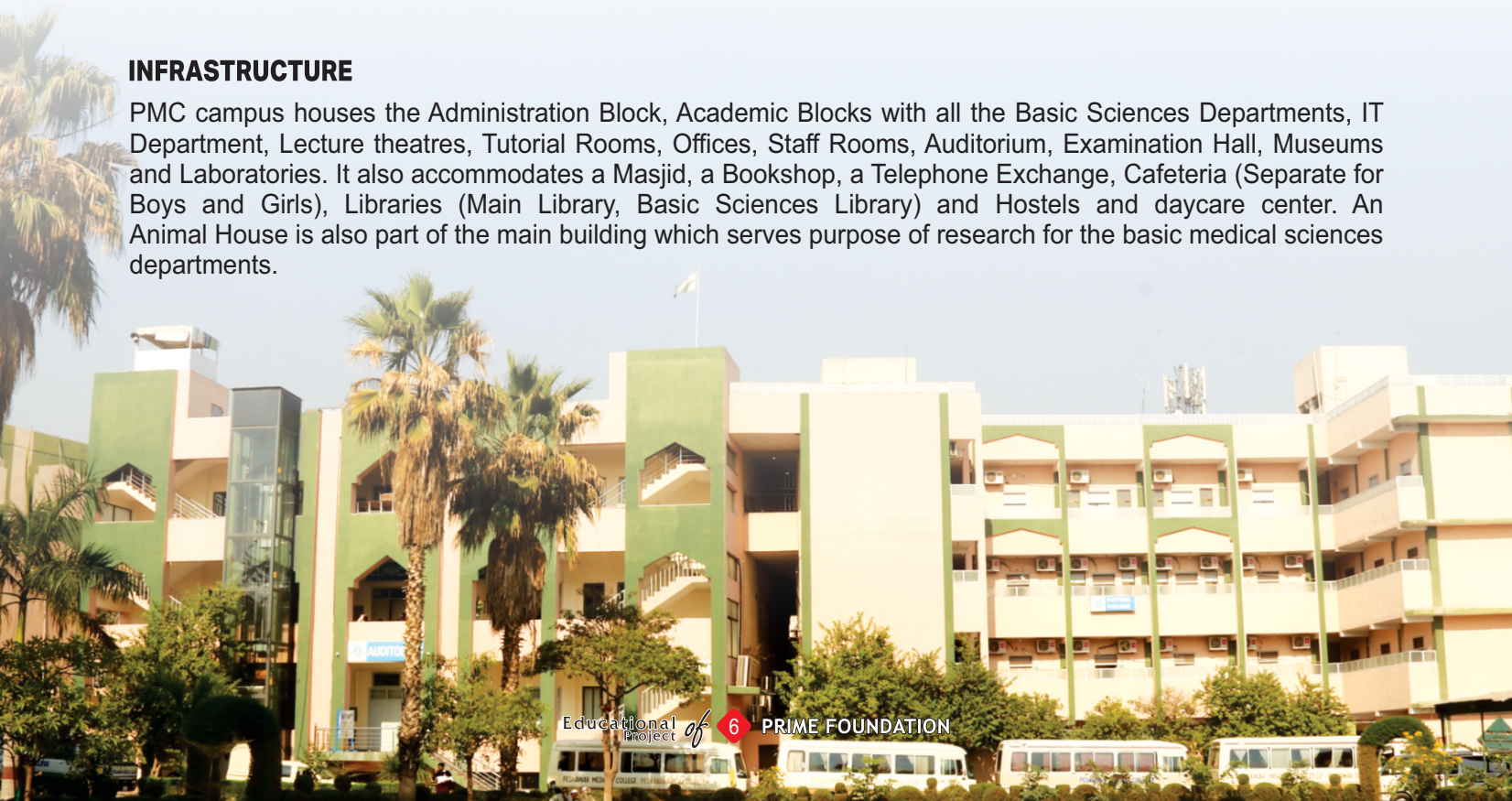


Peshawar Medical College aspires to produce medical graduates with the following minimum attributes:

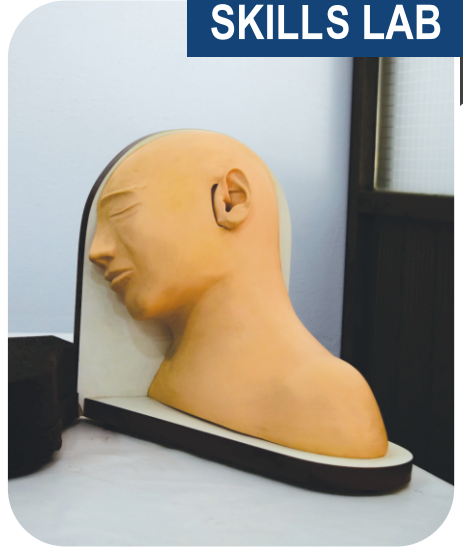


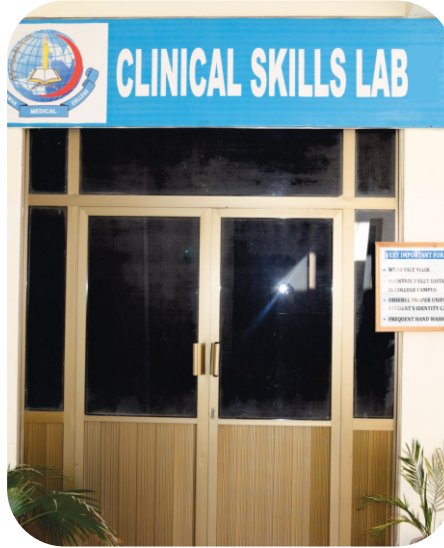

LIBRARY & SELF LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER

Peshawar Medical College (PMC) has a well-organized and resource-rich library network that serves the information needs of its students and faculty. This network comprises three libraries: the Basic Science Library, Main Library, and Boys' Hostel Library, all of which provide a comfortable and conducive environment for study and research.

The libraries are well-resourced, housing an expansive collection of textbooks, reference books, Islamic books, professional medical journals, magazines, and audiovisual materials. To ensure optimal utilization, the libraries offer spacious study areas, covering thousands of square feet, with a seating capacity for about 200 readers. Computer facilities with internet access are also available, facilitating research and learning. The Main Library operates from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM for female day scholars and hostelite while the Boys' Hostel Library remains open 24/7. Moreover, the PDC Library remains open beyond routine timings 3:00 PM - 10:00 PM for boys day scholars.

The libraries provide a range of services and resources, including medical textbooks with multiple copies for borrowing, a separate collection of reference books for consultation, and an extensive journal collection. The library provides instant digital reference support to its users. Users can also access the wide range of contents through HEC Digital Library, leverage Wi-Fi services, and receive live assistance. The libraries are managed by highly qualified staff dedicated to supporting users' academic and research endeavors.

Library

Any trainee, who loses, defaces or otherwise seriously damages any book, is liable to replace the same or pay the cost of the book. If the book is one of the set or series, the cost of the whole set or series will be charged from the concerned trainee.

Hostel accommodation will be subject to availability and will be given only after the full payment of accommodation fee according to the existing rules.

Identity Card

The trainee will be issued a non-transferable identity card having a recent photograph duly signed by the Director. This card must be kept by the trainee within the premises.

Duplicate cards will not be issued except under special circumstances and after permission from Director Postgraduate Department.

Course Distribution

M. Phil program is a full-time, two years structured program spread over 4 semesters (Two semesters per academic year).

The program must be completed in HEC/University stipulated time.

OFFICE OF RESEARCH

As part of its quality package, Peshawar Medical College has always focused on inculcating a strong sense of Research and Bioethics at both the undergraduate and faculty levels. Office of Research set up at PMC organizes, facilitates and promotes this goal by providing progressive guidance, training & capacity building workshops, and a detailed system for high quality research at the institute.

Rotation in research and workshops on various areas of research methodology are a part of the curriculum. INSTITUTIONAL REVIEW BOARD

DEPARTMENT OF UNDERGRADUATE MEDICAL RESEARCH

Peshawar Medical College (PMC), Peshawar Dental College (PDC) and Rufaidah Nursing College (RNC) are student centered colleges. These institutes were established with a clear objective of producing doctor and nurses who are professionally competent with excellent ethical values and practices and are research-minded.

Research has been incorporated in the curriculum, right from first year. The Department of Undergraduate Medical Research (UMR), which is implementing this part of the curriculum, is rightly proud of this pioneering work among Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical colleges, both in Public and Private sectors.

Recently, research curricula for all years of MBBS and BDS have been revised. The new curricula are being implemented from year 2018 onward. The third year MBBS students now have a 3-week rotation at the department of UMR during which emphasis is laid on research ethics, skills and proposal development. Qualified faculty members from basic science, clinical sciences and social sciences supervise students' research projects. The students are made well aware of the importance of research ethics and all research projects have to be approved by the Ethical Review Committee. The fourth year students have to conduct a mandatory research study and write the research report to qualify for the final year. The students are encouraged to publish their research studies and provided with the necessary guidance. Students of PMC, PDC and Rufaida Nursing College have presented their research work both at national and international forums. As a reward for contributing to research, the students and their supervisors are awarded incentives once their research is published in HEC-recognized journals.



Vision: To create leaders in health sciences research

Mission: To provide an enabling environment for creativity and excellence in all domains of health science research at undergraduate level, directed towards socio-economic well-being.

Since its inception, Peshawar Medical College organizes a national annual undergraduate medical research conference that has become an integral academic/co-curricular activity. The Undergraduate Medical Research Department has provided a platform where 1,831 undergraduate research projects have been presented so far. HOSTELS

Hostel Facilities at Peshawar Medical College (PMC) and Peshawar Dental College (PDC)

Peshawar Medical College (PMC) and Peshawar Dental College (PDC) provide separate, secure hostel accommodations for male and female students, designed to foster a conducive environment for academic and personal growth. Each hostel is equipped with round-the-clock security personnel and CCTV surveillance at entrances and corridors to ensure safety.

The hostels offer modern amenities, including air-conditioned rooms furnished with beds, wardrobes, study tables, and chairs. Additional facilities include a 24/7 library, uninterrupted electricity with generator backup, hot water in all washrooms, and access to indoor and outdoor sports facilities. These amenities create an environment that supports both professional education and the development of ethical values, aligning with the colleges' vision of "excellence in professional competence and ethical values."

BOYS HOSTEL

Hostel Admission Process Due to limited availability, students seeking hostel accommodation are encouraged to apply promptly using the designated hostel application form, available from the Chief Warden. Hostel seat allocation is determined on a merit-based, first-come, first-serve basis. Applicants and their parents are required to review the hostel rules and regulations booklet, provided with the application form, prior to submission.

Financial Information

- Hostel rent is charged annually, with a minimum occupancy period of six months for billing purposes.
- Mess charges are payable monthly.
- Electricity consumption is monitored via pre-paid meters and charged accordingly.

Hostel Policies

- Entry or stay of individuals of the opposite gender in the hostels is strictly prohibited.
- Female students may only leave the hostel premises with visitors pre-approved by their parents at the time of admission.

FACILITIES

MASAJID

Both PMC and PDC campuses have their own spacious, purpose-built, well furnished and air conditioned Masajid. The Masajid have separate congregational prayer zones for male and female Muslims.

TRANSPORT

The college has separate transport facilities for male and female students that provide pick and drop services within the city area on defined routes. Transport facility is also utilized for field visits, academic & excursion tours etc. Transport for day scholar is in optional facility and shall be charged annually but will be calculated on the basis of three months slot.

PARKING

Both the campuses (campus 1 & 2) as well as allied teaching hospitals of the college have parking facilities for the staff and visitors. With a view to effect social uniformity, students are not allowed to bring their vehicles in the college.

A book shop on PMC campus provides an easy access to staff & students to get medical literature including text book, stationery, clinical equipment etc. at subsidized rates.

Institution offers quality photocopying services at market rate to its students on campus for their assignments.

TELEPHONE FACILITY

Mobile Phones must be kept on silent mode during the college and hospital hours. However, in case of emergency during teaching hours, the students may avail telephone facility for making local or distant calls within the country to their parents/relatives after prior permission from the concerned teachers.

1. Students are required to follow college notifications, instructions issued by the Dean/Principal or by some other authority on their behalf.
2. Students are required to show decent and disciplined behavior in the classrooms. Students are forbidden to act in a manner which is unbecoming of a medical student inside the college /hostel/hospitals premises and outside.
3. Students are required to strictly observe college dress code.
4. The students must display their name cards while in the college premises or at the hospitals.
5. Students are required to observe punctually on all notified events and in the classes.
6. Every students is required to attend at least 75% of lectures, lab practical/clinical rotations/tutorials etc. Repeated absence from lecture, classes, and demonstrations and from hospital ward will make a student liable to expulsion from the college.
7. Students are not allowed to leave the lecture hall, practical class or hospital ward without the permission of the teacher.
8. No student will be allowed to leave the premises of the college and hospitals during working hours without written permission.
9. No student will be allowed to take the exam unless he/she has cleared all the dues and produced NOC from related departments at the time of submission of examination forms.
10. No student will be enrolled the next class unless he/she has deposited the college fee and other dues for the class.
11. Security measure to handle chemicals, equipment, instruments or reagents are to be strictly observed.
12. For purpose of leave, the students must apply in writing and give reason for his/her request.
13. Students are prohibited from using foul language, physical jokes or fighting.
14. Shouting, sloganeering, making noises or singing on the college/hostel/hospital premises are contrary to the decent behavior and conduct, therefore are not allowed.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT CONDUCT

15. Political activities are strictly forbidden in the college and the hostels in any forum, associated with the college. The college Disciplinary Committee will strictly deal with such cases. The punishment may include expulsion from the college.
16. Students shall not be allowed to address a press conference, or write or communicate by other means to the press on any issues related to the college, hospital, university or government without prior approval by the college.
17. No person shall be invited to address a meeting or society in the college premises without prior written permission of the Principal/Dean.
18. Students are not allowed to bring the outsiders in the college/hospitals/hostels premises without prior permission of the Principal/Dean.
19. Every part of the college building and hostel premises shall be kept clean, i.e. walls, fixtures, classrooms, lab equipment, books, specimens, charts, etc. should not be tampered with, mutilated or damaged in any way or form. Perpetrators will face strict disciplinary actions.
20. No poster or banner shall be displayed in the college /hostel/hospital premises without the approval of the Principal/Dean.
21. Socially unacceptable activities (gambling/use of narcotics/possession of arms, etc) are forbidden.
22. All accidents, major or minor shall have to be reported immediately to the college authorities
23. If a student has any complaint, he/she has to submit it in writing to the Vice Principal who will forward it to the Principal/Dean of the college for necessary action (if required).
24. Student desirous of addressing the Dean/Principal by a letter must do so individually. Joint applications shall be considered as breach of discipline & will not be entertained.
25. Student who wishes to make a representation on any subject has the right of direct access to the Principal or Dean during college hours by prior appointment.

PMC UNIFORM

Uniform Guidelines

Male Students:

Attire:

- Plain black dress pants with a plain white dress shirt or
- White shalwar kameez
- Jeans, jogger trousers or tights are not allowed.

Footwear:

- Black leather shoes or black Peshawari chappal with shalwar kameez

Lab Coat:

- Knee-length, full-sleeved white overall with the college monogram on the left front pocket. Wearing a lab coat is mandatory during laboratory practical sessions, dissection classes, clinical rotations in hospitals, and examinations. Lab coats will be available for purchase at the college or at Brothers Uniform shop opposite to PMC, soon.

Winter Attire:

- Students are required to wear Navy blue blazer with the college monogram on the left front pocket from the next winter season. Blazers will be available for purchase at the college soon or at Brothers Uniform Shop, located opposite Peshawar Medical College.
- Plain black sweater (optional, to be worn under the blazer if desired)
- Jackets, long coats or any other winter accessory are no allowed.

Female Students:

Attire:

- Grey Knee-length shirt with white shalwar
- No trousers, pajama, tights, or any fancy type of shalwar allowed
- Only black-colored abaya is permitted, but the white overall must be worn over the abaya

Head Covering:

- Plain black or white headscarf or dupatta (mandatory) dually covering the hair

Footwear:

- Plain black leather shoes
- Fancy shoes, joggers or shoes with high heels are not allowed

Lab Coat:

- Knee-length, full-sleeved white overall with the college monogram on the lower left pocket. Lab coats will be available for purchase at the college or at Brothers Uniform Shop opposite to PMC, soon.

Winter Attire:

- Plain black sweater (to be worn under the white overall)

ADMISSION POLICY

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

PM&DC Medical and Dental Undergraduate Education (Admissions, Curriculum and Conduct) Policy and Regulations 2025, shall be followed in letter and spirit.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

For the 2025-26 session, all admissions to private medical and dental colleges in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa will be conducted by Khyber Medical University (KMU), Peshawar, in strict accordance with the regulations of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC).

Step 1: Selection and Fee Submission

Candidates must first be selected through the centralized KMU process and deposit the prescribed admission fees.

Step 2: Document Submission

Following selection and fee payment, candidates are required to formally complete their admission by submitting the following original documents for verification:

- KMU Admission Letter (Original)
- Proof of Fee Payment (Original receipt)
- Original Academic and Legal Credentials, including:
- Matriculation (SSC) or equivalent (O-Level) original certificate, detailed marks certificate (DMC), and IBCC equivalence certificate (where applicable).
- Intermediate (HSSC) or equivalent (A-Level) original certificate, detailed marks certificate (DMC), and IBCC equivalence certificate (where applicable).
- Valid entrance exam result card: MDCAT / SAT-II / MCAT / UCAT.
- Photocopy of the student's CNIC or B-Form.
- Photocopies of father's and mother's CNICs.
- Original domicile certificate.
- Twelve (12) recent passport-sized photographs with a blue background.
- For Foreign Applicants Only: Clear copy of valid passport and permanent residence permit.

PAYMENT OF COLLEGE FEE

1. The selected applicant shall be bound to deposit fee within 3 (three) working days failing which the admission offer shall automatically stand withdrawn and next candidate on merit will be issued admission offer.
2. No students shall be required to provide any form of security for payment of fee by a college.
3. Fee shall be paid through Pay Order, Fund Transfer or deposit in bank account while cash may not be accepted by the College.
4. A student shall have the right to pay tuition fee on a quarterly, six monthly or annual basis to the college. A student paying the college on a six monthly basis in advance shall be granted a two percent discount in the tuition fee and a student paying the college on an annual basis in advance shall be granted a four percent discount in the tuition fee.
5. All government taxes, University charges, regulatory body charges will be charged to the student on actual basis subject to change by the concerned authority from time to time.
6. To claim income tax waiver, the parent/guardian/financer of the student will be required to comply related rules as amended from time to time.
7. If a student after having obtained admission seeks either to leave the Programme / college or transfer to other college in the middle of the academic session, the college shall have the right to adjust the tuition fee already paid on prorated basis along with penalty up to 10% of Total Annual Fee. Provided that no penalty shall be imposed upon a student who seeks to leave the program before the closing date of admission in the private medical/dental colleges as notified by the Council.
8. For subsequent professional years, if a student fails to deposit the fee / dues within the stipulated period, the following will be the penalty:
 - a. Rs 1,000 per day for the 1st 15 days' delay
 - b. Rs 2,000 per day from 16th day
9. After expiry of 30 days of the due date for payment of fee/other dues, the Principal is empowered to debar the student from classes, ban to mark attendance and avail any sort of college facilities including library as well as appearing in the examinations. Meanwhile, the Principal will initiate disciplinary proceedings against the defaulter by serving notice of removal from the college to the defaulting student and guardian. After completing all formalities including providing opportunity of being heard, final outcome to be communicated duly endorsed to all concerned departments and student will be liable to be expelled in light of relevant clauses of Admission Regulation "PM&DC Medical and Dental Undergraduate Education (Admissions, Curriculum and Conduct) Policy and Regulations 2025".

10. The name of the student expelled on account of default in payment of tuition fee shall be notified to the Council within one week and the student's registration with the Council shall be cancelled permanently. A student expelled shall not be eligible to seek admission to any other Medical or Dental college for a period of one year.

11. College has the right to take Takaful coverage to minimize any future loss of income at its own expense without charging expense to the students.
